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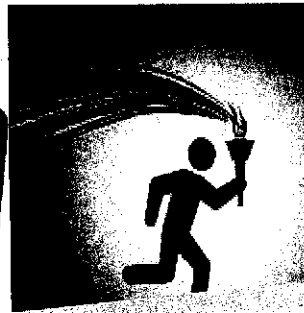
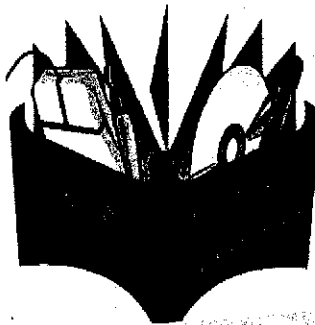

NAXALITE MOVEMENT- CHALLENGE FOR INDIA

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The term "Naxal" derives from the name of the village Naxalabari in West Bengal, where the Movement has its origin. Naxaltes are considered far-left radical communists, supportive of Maoist Political sentiment and ideology. Their origin can be traced to the split in 1967 of the communist party of India, leading to the formation of the Communist Party in India. Initially the movement had its centre in West Bengal. Later it spread into less developed areas of rural southern and eastern India such as Chattisgrah, Oddisa, Andrapradesh.

Around 1971 the Naxalites gained a strong presence among the radical sections of the student Movement in Culcutta. Students left the School and joined the Naxalites. Charu Majumdar who initiated in this declared an "annihilation Line" dictum that Naxalites should assassinate individual Class enemies (such as landlords, businessmen, Politicians, Police officers of the right and left, others)

During the 1970's the Movement was fragmented into disputing factions. By 1980 it was estimated that around 30 Naxalite groups were active with a combined membership of 30,000.
